

- 1. Each student(or student team) will be required to submit a collection of files for a particular lab/project
 - a. Place all files in a folder called "initials lab#" or "initials project#"

<u>For example</u>: John Moses Doe for lab #1 will create a folder called "jmd lab1"

- 2. Note: make sure your name (or the names of the team members) appears in the main program comment header.
- 3. Using a Macintosh, connect to the cps212Drop share: Finder>Go>Connect to server

4. Drag your folder into the cps212drop folder (this should be available on your desktop)

Paperwork needed for project submission

- 1. The <u>project writeup</u> will include a short description of your approach to creating the software for this project. Especially highlight any unique or strange sections of code. Also highlight any sections of code you are especially proud of.
- 2. Describe carefully what parts of your program do not function correctly.
- 3. Describe carefully how to build and then execute your program.
- 4. The <u>project writeup</u> will also include the set of <u>testcases</u> used to test your resulting software along with their results. Be sure these testcases thoroughly test the software.
- 5. The <u>project writeup</u> will need to be in Word or pdf format.

Note: make sure your code is thoroughly documented.
